What if I receive a Notice of Violation (NOV) from the Code Enforcement office?

The city's Code Enforcement Officers issue a Notice of Violation (NOV) when they observe a violation of city code or receive a complaint from citizens.

The most common violation, based on my experience, is uncut grass. Neighbors might phone such a complaint in or a Code Enforcement Officer may notice the high grass. A Notice of Violation is then issued to the resident. Ten (10) days later the code enforcement officer will examine the issue to see if it's been corrected. If it has been corrected, the matter is documented and filed; no charges are pursued.

If the violation has <u>not been corrected</u>, a Citation Summon will be issued for the violator to appear in Municipal Court on the date noted in the Summon. Violations not corrected may be pursued by civil and criminal action.
