[Tivity health and wellness program comes to Snyder Recreation Center...](#)

Tivity reimburses the Department of Parks & Recreation for certain senior citizen fitness classes and memberships at Snyder Recreational Center. There are 3 programs available: (A) [SilverSneakers](#) - \$2.50 per member visit; cap of \$20/member/month; fully subsidized program for Medicare, Group Retirees and Older Adults that includes a basic fitness membership; (B) [Prime Program](#) - \$3.50 per member visit; cap of \$30/member/month; commercial fully subsidized program that includes basic fitness membership. In addition, a thirty (30) minute personalized orientation session or personal training session is included; (3) [Private Brand Program](#) - \$3.50 per member visit; cap of \$30/member/month; *participant pays* a monthly payment to Tivity Health to participate in the program; commercial fully subsidized program that includes basic fitness membership; a thirty (30) minute personalized orientation session or personal training session is included. 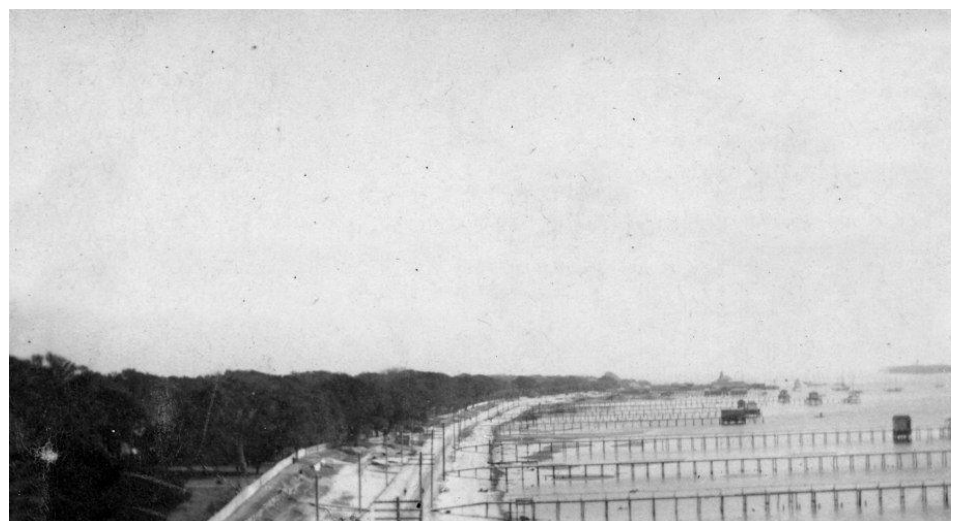
