Spring is just around the corner, so if you, the property owner, are trimming your shrubs, pile them curbside and let Pelican Waste & Debris know your pile is there by giving them a call... 228.232.0850. Be sure trimmings are no longer than 4 feet in length! **Note:** If a contractor is trimming trees on your property, that contractor is required to haul the trimmings away. The contractor should also have a Tree Permit from the city in hand before the work begins. Remodeling your home? Pelican Waste, under the terms of their contract with the Harrison County Utility Authority (HCUA), is not required to pick your remodeling waste. The contractor you hired (or you) should haul it off.

That temporary fencing you'll notice going up in the near future just west of Caillavet Street, on Highway 90 by MGM Park? A pedestrian overpass expected to be completed in December.

Finally, Mississippi Gulf Coast Spring Break occurs April 13-15... I'll be providing Neighborhood Passes (Thank you Biloxi Police Department) for residents at Oakmont Place, Gulf Beach RV Resort, Maison d'Orleans Apartments, Briarfield subdivision, Grande View Apartments, Edgewater Park subdivision, and Beau View condominiums. These passes should (1) permit you to turn off Highway 90 to your home if "venting" is initiated on Highway 90 due to traffic gridlock, and (2) permit you to access the Coliseum shortcut to/from Beauvoir Rd.
