- (1) Approved a zoning map amendment for a 43 acre tract of land from its current zoning district classification of LB Limited Business and RS-10 Low-Density Single-Family Residential to PD-TND: Planned Development- Traditional Neighborhood Development, 2330 Atkinson Road (Bertucci Development) [Video discussion at the 2:40 mark](#)
- (2) Approved Friday, July 5, a discretionary holiday for city employees (not emergency personnel)
- (3) Approved bid of Lane Construction for infrastructure repair project, Area 10, Sixth Street South

Major Ron Lessner, Biloxi Police Department, notes that: (1) the Coliseum "shortcut" will be open on heavy traffic days during this event, (2) Neighborhood Passes will not be issued, and (3) BPD officers will be posted at Briarfield and Pine Grove avenues to limit traffic into that neighborhood.
