**SSXS Sixth Street, next infrastructure scheduled to begin...**

Lane Construction Company has been awarded the bid to repair the next phase of infrastructure replacement referred to as "Area 10 Sixth Street South (SXSS)". The bid was \$10,527,258 for the 550 calendar days, to begin after Notice to Proceed is given, needed to complete the project. [See the map](#)

**Boring Update in Ward ...**

- C-Spire – Boring in Ward 5 is complete. C-Spire will have crews in to start pulling fiber soon but digging and boring are finished.
- AT&T – Boring is complete in the Channel Mark area; AT&T crews will be in the area splicing cable for this new fiber project until about mid-July.
- Center Point – Boring is currently underway for a new gas main on Fernwood Road from Gulfwater Drive to just past Faulkner Road. This project includes Fernwood Road, Faulkner Road, Hickory Road and Pecan Road.
