The first overhauled beachfront "dune" drain pipe along the coast has been completed. Located between the small craft harbor and Harrah's casino, the structures will improve the visual appeal of beaches and reduce erosion. The work is being paid for with part of Mississippi's allocation of \$23 million in Gulf of Mexico Energy Security Act funds. A second "dune" is now under construction just east of the I-110 loop.
