**Pine Grove Avenue drainage project...**

A pre-construction meeting by the contractor working the Pine Grove drainage project, DNA Underground, is being scheduled. The project will be explained and residents should attend to have their questions answered. Date TBD.

**Churchill Avenue ditch improvement...**

Supervisor Connie Rockco has earmarked \$50,000 for this proposed project to pipe the ditch on the west side of Churchill Avenue. If other scheduled projects come in under budget (say, on the Pine Grove drainage project), those savings may be used for this project. The current status of this project should be considered "iffy".
