The city still incents new housing units in the downtown restoration area (bordered on the west by I-110; south by the gulf; east of Lee Street; and north to the north side of Division Street) through private enterprise in renovation of existing building and new construction. Grants up to \$25,000 per housing unit are available through Biloxi Main Street.
