Sharing the latest information I have with you:

- The Ward 6 (Kenny Glavan, Councilman) meeting scheduled for tonight is closed to the public. Instead, a recorded session of directors' reports and presenters will be videoed and broadcast on the city's [BTV website](#) and the city's [YouTube channel](#).
- City leaders are asking that only those with pending business before the Council attend the council meeting tomorrow at 1:30; seating will be restricted. The seating restriction will apply to the council workshop, prior to the regularly scheduled meeting, on Coast Transit Funding as well.
- A Resolution declaring a state of emergency will be added to tomorrow's Council agenda.
- Biloxi Municipal Court will not be in session this week, however, the court itself remains open for those scheduled to make payments or perform court-appointed work. An [administrative order](#) issued by the court today continues all cases for at least two weeks, through 5:00 pm, Friday, March 27.
- The Parks & Recreation department announced that all youth sports through the end of March have been postponed.
- The Biloxi Planning Commission meeting scheduled for Thursday, March 19, is being rescheduled to a later date.
- Biloxi Bay Area Chamber of Commerce announced that the Law Enforcement Banquet scheduled for March 18 has been postponed, to be rescheduled at a later date.
- Public libraries in Biloxi and throughout Harrison County will be closed to the public Tuesday through Saturday this week. Library leaders will evaluate later in the week whether to extend the closure.
- All Senior Olympics events scheduled through April 2 have been postponed, to be rescheduled at a later date.
- All Senior classes and field trips scheduled for March through the City of Biloxi Senior Programs have been cancelled.
