This event draws a much smaller crowd than Cruisin' the Coast but, at times, may present traffic issues, particularly on Highway 90 and Beauvoir Road. Also, there appears to be more tourists in town enjoying the beach this summer.

The city's Event Traffic Plan will be in effect to prevent gridlock; it's the same traffic plan as last year. [See the traffic plan](#)

Reminders...

- The City of Biloxi now uses a real-time, on-the-go messaging system to advise residents and visitors of traffic information and other advisories directly to your cell phone... and it's FREE!
 - To sign up: On your cell phone, text BILOXI to 888777
 - You'll receive a follow-up message asking for your ZIP code in the event the city transmits a geo-targeted message.
 - If you decide at any time to not receive B-Alert messages, just reply: STOP
- If you're going to be out and about this weekend, leave a few minutes earlier than usual to arrive at your destination on time; don't be in a hurry... be patient.
- You may have noticed that barricades for traffic control are already staged on Highway 90 for placement during this event.
- Orange traffic cones will be placed in the middle of the eastbound and westbound lanes on Highway 90.
- Follow directions of law enforcement officers directing traffic.
