Information for the residents of Briarfield subdivision, Grande View apartments, Maison d'Orleans apartments, and Marshall Road:

(1) The "coliseum shortcut" will be open Fri, Oct. 9, 4:00 pm–Sat., Oct. 10, midnight or a bit later, (2) The east end of Marshall Road will be closed, and (3) Police cruisers and barricades will be at Pine Grove & Beacon and Briarfield & Beacon to limit entry of non-residents into your neighborhood. Your county taxes will not increase for Fiscal Year 2021, remaining at 36.42 mills. Projected revenue is about \$118 million: \$65 million from property tax, \$23.8 million in state and federal revenue, and \$16.5 million in revenue from sources like fines, forfeitures, and charges for services.
