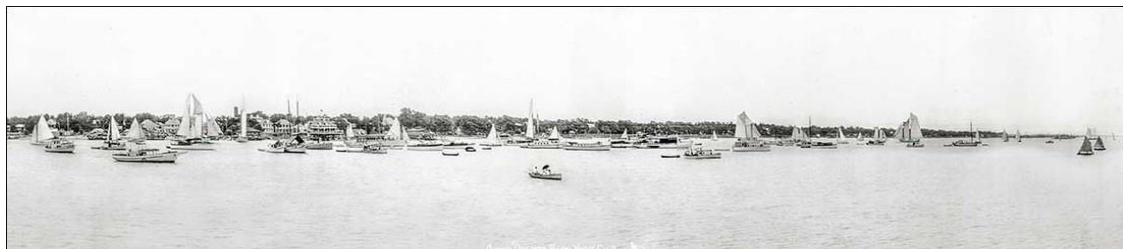

The Municipal Court of the City of Biloxi has jurisdiction over all traffic offenses and misdemeanor criminal violations that occur within the city limits of Biloxi. The court also has jurisdiction of juveniles charged with traffic offenses (including DUI), liquor law violations, tobacco violations and juveniles certified as adults or previously arrested as an adult.
