I drove Ward 5 Thursday from 10:20-2:20 and spoke with some of you; most of you were doing what we do after hurricanes, cleaning up.

The question asked most frequently was *When will we have power?*

Some of you now have power while others wait... there's an update below from Mississippi Power.

- Mississippi Power crews, many from out of state, are powering up the city of Biloxi... [read the latest update](#).
 - Biloxi is under curfew from 11:00 pm tonight/Friday through 6:00 am tomorrow morning... essential travel only.
 - Your weekly garbage, trash and recycling pick has been moved back one (1) day.
 - Next week the city's storm debris contractors will be picking up storm debris that you've place curbside.
 - Haul storm debris to the curb. Contractors cannot come on private property to pick up debris.
 - Do not pile debris close to telephone poles, light poles, or mailboxes.
 - Please do not bag storm debris; the contractor prefers the debris to be visible and unbagged.
 - *If you've already bagged storm debris*, leave it curbside and Pelican Waste, our regular trash contractor, will pick it up.
 - Treat intersections with inoperative or destroyed traffic signals as 4-way STOPs.
 - If trick or treating on Halloween/tomorrow night, do it safely... lots of debris piles in neighborhoods and we're in the middle of a pandemic.
