- (1) Approved receipt of state funds, \$647,269
- (2) Approved contract for Point Cadet traffic study... The Point Cadet traffic study area is bounded by Hwy 90/south, Oak Street/west, Back Bay Boulevard/north, and Biloxi Bay/east and includes 12 intersections. Improvements for two potential projects that will be analyzed are: (1) Ramp connection to the Biloxi-Ocean Springs bridge for westbound ramp to Howard Avenue and (2) Back Bay Boulevard extension from Oak Street to Highway 90 in the vicinity of Pine Street.

Railroad crossings to close permanently...

Tomorrow two railroad crossings in east Biloxi, Dorries Street and Nixon Street, will close permanently. No closure dates have been announced for four other railroad crossings in east Biloxi: Delauney Street, Querens Avenue, Iroquois Street and Holley Street. The city and CSX Railroad came to agreement 18 months ago to close six crossings and create two new crossings at a future date yet to be determined, one for the Popp's Ferry Road extension and the other for the extension of Pine Street.
