Low-Speed Vehicles (LSV)... [See the ordinance & state statute](#) [Video](#)

As with all new ordinances that are put into effect, the opportunity exists for individual "interpretations" of what it means, the dos and don'ts if you will. Here are some key things to note, in no particular order:

- LSV is a four (4) wheeled electric vehicle with a top speed of 25 mph
- LSVs may operate on streets with posted speed limit of 25 mph or below
- LSVs may not operate on, over, or across interstate or state highways
They are not permitted to cross Hwy 90 or operate south of Hwy 90
- Drivers may cross streets that exceed 25 MPH but the crossing must be at the closest signalized intersection (will be on map that's noted below)
- Driver of the LSV is subject to all state & city traffic and parking laws
- Annual registration with the Biloxi Police Department is required; \$75 fee
Biloxi Police Department will inspect the LSV for required safety equipment, proof of financial responsibility, and insurance
- The LSV driver is required to have a valid driver's license in his/her possession while operating the vehicle
- Owner of the LSV must sign an acknowledgment that he/she has read and understands the city's ordinance and that the vehicle complies with the city's ordinance
- The registration decal is to be displayed on the left, rear fender
This decal is non-transferrable
- \$500 fine per occurrence for operating the vehicle without a decal, expired decal, or decal registered to another owner or vehicle
- BPD may refuse to register or revoke an issued permit if the vehicle or owner is involved in 3 or more violations within one (1) year
- The city is required to provide a map indicating where LSVs may be operated at the time of registration within the city of Biloxi
- LSVs must have certain equipment; [see 49 CFR Section 571.500](#)
- ✓ The permitting process and appropriate forms are still in development
- ✓ The map where LSVs will be permitted to operate is still in development
