LED streetlights...

The city's Chief Administrative Office, Mike Leonard, mentioned at Tuesday's Council meeting that Mississippi Power will be upgrading city streetlights with LED lights that use less energy, require less maintenance, and last longer than the lights currently in use. Leonard noted that the work will begin on Debuys Road and progress to the east. No word on when this work will begin. Mississippi Power Company's service area in Biloxi is south of Biloxi bay; Coast Electric serves the city north of the bay.
