The [Port's proposed budget](#) was reviewed followed by a review of the [Non-Department](#) requests agreed to by the Council. Documents from this workshop: [Non-Department requests, revised](#) [Department budgets, revised](#) [City Tax/Millage Levy, historical](#) Publication dates for the proposed FY2022 budget are August 24 and 31. The Public Hearing on the budget will be Tuesday, September 7, 5:15 pm, prior to the regularly scheduled Council meeting at 6:00. Council will meet in a special meeting Tuesday, September 14, likely at 1:30, to vote on the FY2022 budget. The tax levy, 30.10 mills, is not expected to increase. A reduction in the school tax levy is expected, from approximately 43.37 to 43.25 mills.
