Two additional large self-loading trucks and trailers, similar to those used after Hurricane Zeta, will be deployed in a 5-day effort to clear neighborhoods of downed limbs and yard waste.

When you move stuff to the curb, remember to:

(1) Separate the material into separate piles... limbs... bagged items (leaves)... and other trash.
Unbagged leaves will not be picked up.

(2) Do not place piles near utility poles, fire hydrants, gas meters, mailboxes or pole guide wires.

The trucks/trailers will begin pick up Monday, September 27, 6:00 am, and will continue through Friday, October 1.

I suggest you move your piles to the curb and have them ready for pick up early Monday morning.

I don't know where the pick up will begin nor do I know when they will be in your neighborhood.
