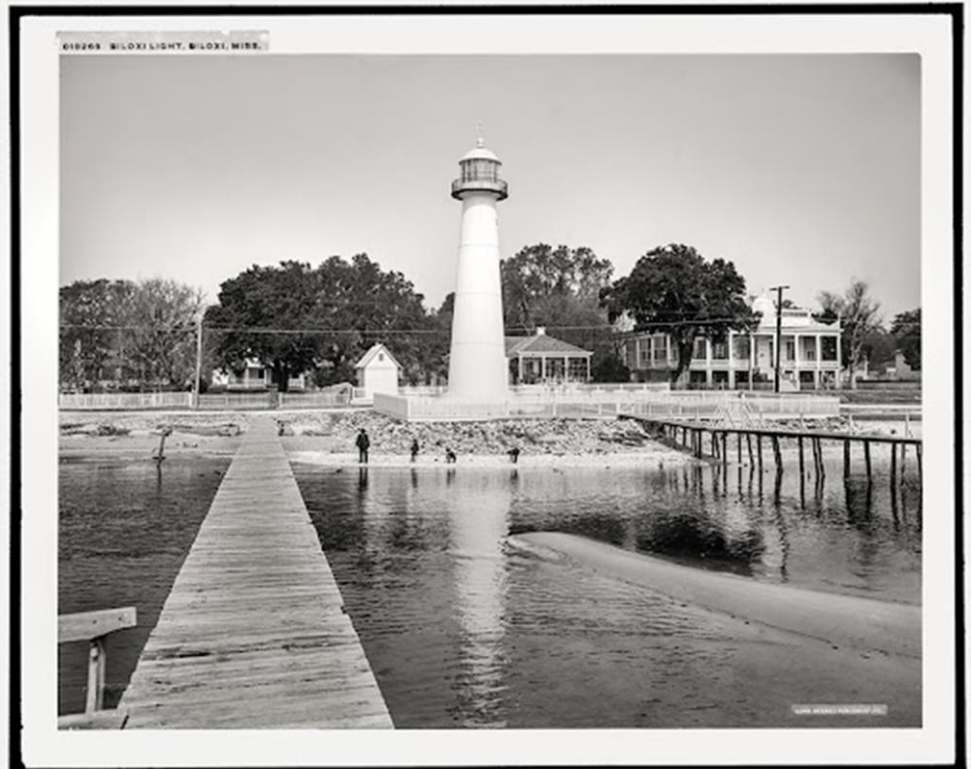

Apparently, the police department's records management system was not sending data to the Crime Mapping server. The department will move to a new crime mapping platform in April.

Mississippi Power, transmission line poles...

Mississippi Power Co. recently replaced two transmission line poles on Old Bay Road and one pole on Bay Pointe Drive. They're BIG poles, either metal or concrete, and require large cranes to place the poles. Three more poles will be placed on Atkinson Road during the month of March, so please drive carefully where these installation crews are working.
