- Conducted First Reading, temporary signs (streamers, feather flags, etc)
- Approved conditional use permit for short-term rental, 244 Reynoir St.
- Approved preliminary subdivision approval, 2506 Beach Blvd, 39 houses
- Approved CDBG grant for afterschool program, ages 5-13, June-July

Fireworks ordinance revised... [See the ordinance with revisions noted](#)

The fireworks ordinance was revised in February. Significant changes are: Unlawful to shoot fireworks anywhere in the city except for:

- July 4, December 31, 6:00 pm–January 1, 1:00 am & Tet Dragon Dance
- Can't throw fireworks from a motor vehicle or along a parade route
- Can't explode fireworks within 1,000 ft. of church, school, or hospital
- No fireworks sold to kids 16 years or younger; be over 21 to sell fireworks
- No firework sales before June 15 and after July 4
- No firework sales before December 5 and after January 1

What's up with the old Winn Dixie store?

Several folks have asked recently about activity at the old Winn Dixie store by the intersection of Pass Road & Popp's Ferry Road. I'm hearing that the row of stores on that property was recently sold; the new owner is cleaning up the old Winn Dixie in hopes of luring a Rouse's or Corner Market. Keep your fingers crossed!
