## **Rich Avenue speed limit change...**

Drivers who travel through Bay Vista subdivision, particularly those who drive Rich Avenue, should note that the speed limit on Rich Avenue was recently lowered to 15 mph. The city's Traffic Committee recommended the change after the Biloxi Police Department conducted a traffic study.

## **Part of Beauvoir Road closed in November...**

Approximately 500 feet of Beauvoir Road, from just north of Highway 90, is scheduled to be closed in November for a period of three (3) months. The closure is to replace infrastructure (water, sewer, drainage) associated with project BEA2. I'll share updates as I receive them on this closure.

## **16<sup>th</sup> Annual Cemetery Tour, two performances...**

The annual Old Biloxi Cemetery Tour is Sunday, October 16, from 2 to 4 p.m. and then the tour repeats on Tuesday, October 18, 2022 from 5 to 7 p.m. This is the same tour on both dates. The event is a self-guided, continuously performed event, so attendees may arrive anytime and witness all ten re-enactments. This year's theme, *Music Makers of Biloxi*, features tales of musicians of Biloxians and more. In keeping with tradition, this is a free public event but donations are welcome. The tour will showcase history-based reenactments at graveside. Walking entrance to the tour can be accessed either from the Highway 90 gate or from Irish Hill. Refreshments will be provided.
