## Next budget workshop... Watch last Monday's Budget Workshop (1:48:58)

There is a <u>Budget Workshop</u> scheduled for Monday, August 5, 1:30, at city hall. Two new recurring expenditures are (1) increased employer contributions to the state retirement system and (2) hiring nine additional firefighters to man the new Fire Station 10 on Old Highway 67. Together they total about \$1,000,000.

## Status of Pine Grove Avenue Drainage repairs...

The contract has been awarded. Once the city's received the signed documents (about 7-10 days) from the contractor, a task order will be issued to perform the work. The contractor will then order supplies/materials, typically a 2-3 weeks. Look for the contractor to be on site at the end of August with an estimated completion date of seven (7) weeks (mid-October). If you like, I'll line up a pre-construction meeting by the contractor with residents in the Pine Grove Avenue area... Let me know. (I can't name the contractor until the documents are signed.)
