Infrastructure repair/replacement moves forward... [See map](#)

A \$10.5 million, 550-day contract, SXSS, has been awarded to Lane Construction to install new water, sewer and drainage lines in the area south of the CSX railway, involving three miles of roads from the tip of the peninsula at Michael Boulevard, south to Third Street and west to Hoxie. Among the streets that will be impacted, all south of the railway: Oak, Maple Wisteria, Tchula, Fourth, Fifth, and sections of Howard and Third. Plans for Phase 3 (STM 1 and STM2) are being reviewed and anticipated to be out for bids in December.
