## Don't forget to prep your trash for pickup...

[Pelican Waste](#), the trash/yard waste contractor, wants you to be aware that if they don't pick up your trash on your usual pick up day (Friday, in Ward 5) they'll get it the next day. Significantly more homeowners (due to the virus/shelter order) are doing spring cleaning and yard work this year.

- Leaves and grass clippings must be bagged
- If you hire a contractor to do work, the contractor must remove all waste, whether it's trimming a tree or construction debris
- Limbs must be less than 8 feet in length
- Trash/rubbish won't be collected from vacant lots or empty homes
- All piles must be within 3 to 5 feet of the roadway
- No hazardous waste, medical waste, tires, paints will be picked up
