## Infrastructure updates, STM1 & STM2 and BEA 1, 2 & 3... [See map](#)

December 1st is the anticipated date for Necaise Brothers, Inc., to proceed with the infrastructure replacement in east Biloxi, Point Cadet by St. Michael's church. The \$41.4M project is on a 300 day timeline.

Design engineers have submitted draft plans for BEA 1, 2, and 3 for city review. The bid package for these projects is expected to hit the streets in the next several weeks. Estimated cost is in the neighborhood of \$18M.
