Pelican Waste & Debris extends service...

Pelican Waste, the city's waste contractor, will be pick up curbside bags of household waste that do not fit in HCUA provided carts (the brown ones) from Monday, November 2 to Friday, November 13. This will provide help with spoiled food of residents who lacked power following Hurricane Zeta. (Do not use previous contractors' carts as they will not be picked up.) Pelican Waste will also continue picking up yard waste that is less than 8 cubic yards in size or less per resident. Routes are intended to be on normal pick up days but this may be a challenge due to more debris than normal following the storm.
