Avoid having your packages stolen by porch pirates...

- * Have your package delivered to your work.
- * Have your package delivered to the home of a relative or friend.
- * Have your package held at the post office for pickup.
- * Request your package have signature confirmation upon delivery.
- * Ask your carrier to place the package in an area out of plain view

Storm related repairs on your home? A word of advice...

There is no cost for hurricane-related construction permits through April 20, 2021. If you're having hurricane-related repairs made to your home/property by a contractor, have the contractor get the appropriate building permit from the city's Community Development department. If you, the homeowner, get the building permit, the city cannot support you when pursuing claims of shoddy work by the contractor. *More Questions?* Contact the Community Development office, 228.435.6280.
