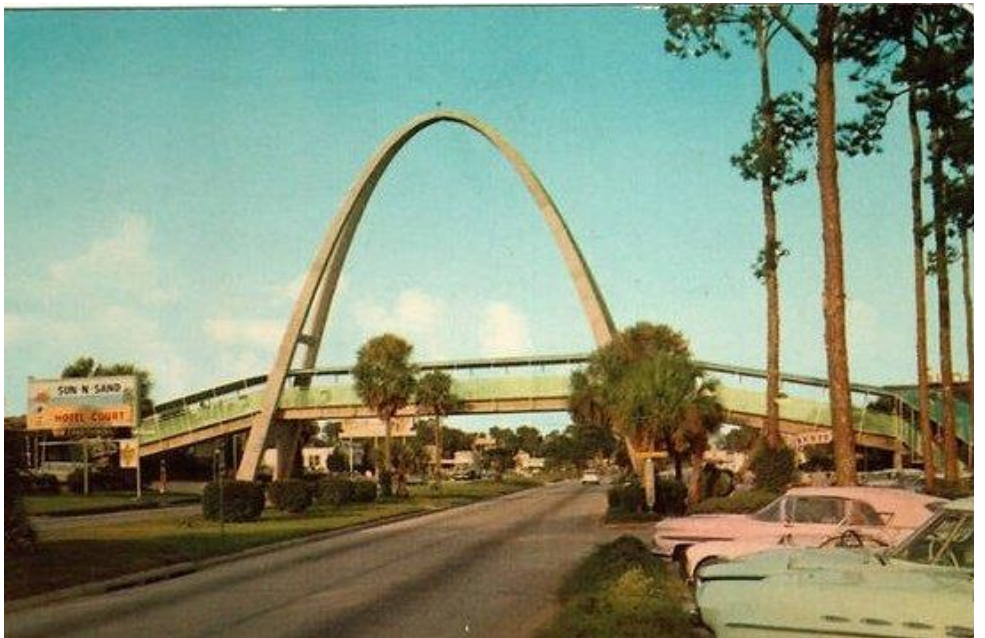

Qualifying period for 2021 Mayor and Council candidates...
Interested in running for Mayor or a City Council seat? The qualifying period for candidates is January 4 through February 5. Candidates must be a resident of Biloxi for two years. The first Primary Election is Tuesday, April 6; a second Primary Election (if necessary) is scheduled for Tuesday, April 27. The General Election is slated for Tuesday, June 8. The mayor's salary is \$115,898; a council member's salary is \$29,648. The offices come with city insurance benefits and use of a cell phone.
