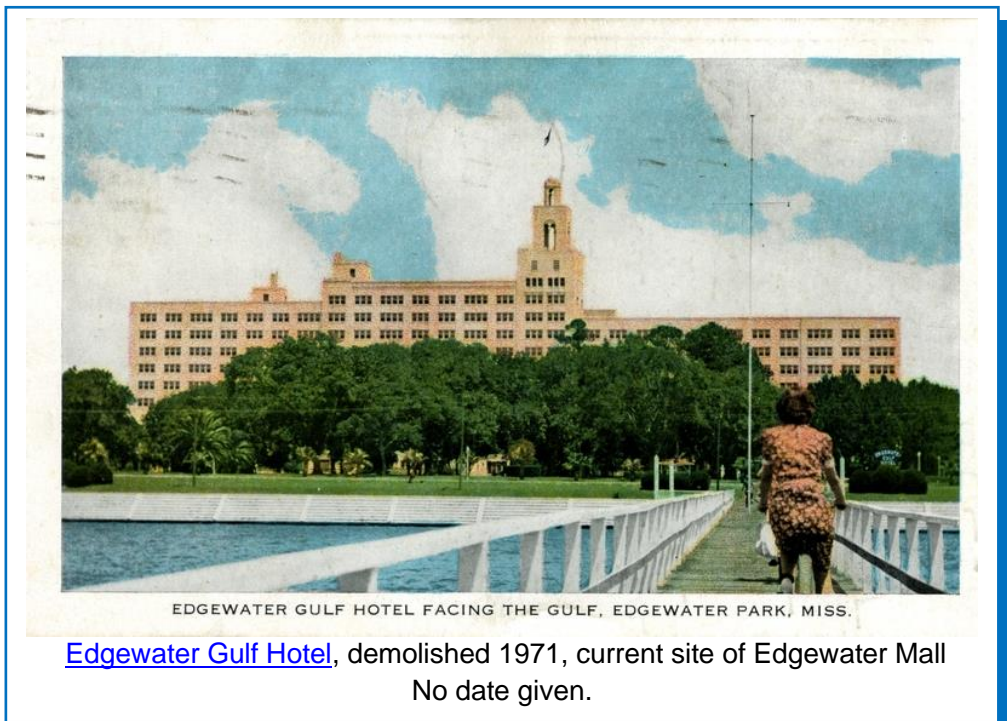
► There is no Council meeting this week; our next meeting is March 16.

Paving Debuys Road, the latest...

Earlier this week I checked with Harrison County Supervisor Connie Rockco on a timeline for this project since it will be overseen by the county. As you read this, the City of Gulfport has not yet approved a resolution to finance their third of the project cost, about \$28,000. Once the county receives the Gulfport resolution and it's approved by the Board of Supervisors, the work (resurfacing Debuys from Pass Road to Runnymede) will be scheduled.
