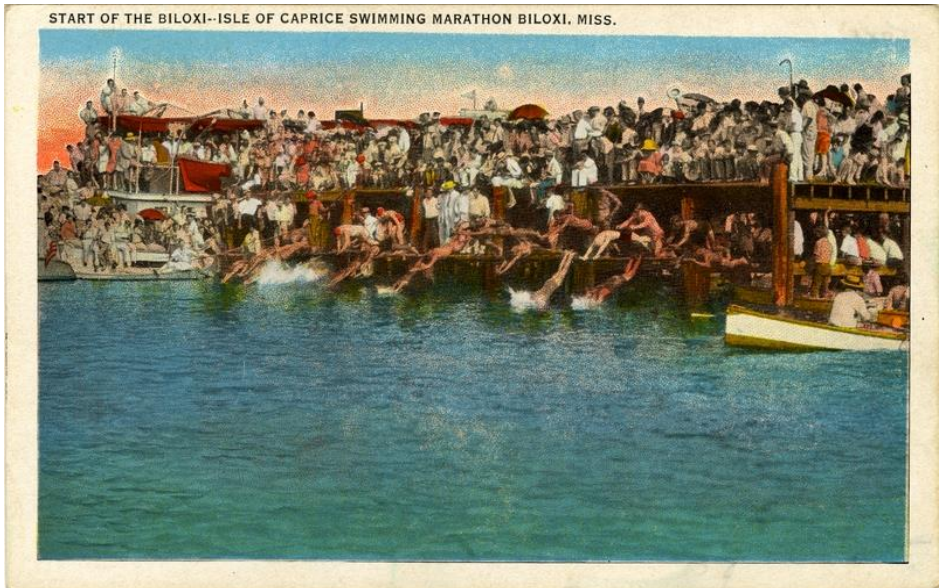

Highlights of this past week's Council Meeting... [Video \(1:16:53\)](#)

- 1) Approved zone change for 2462 Beacon Place from RS-10 to RM-10
- 2) Renewed the city's property insurance, \$2,081,868 (a 10% increase)
- 3) Approved emergency repair, Popp's Ferry bridge fender system w/lights
- 4) Approved MOU with County to construct boat ramp at Camellia Street
- 5) Approved No Wake zones at Popp's Ferry Causeway Park, boat launch
- 6) Approved installation of a new water well by the Bay Vista fire station

"Neighborhood Passes" will be delivered to you this week for use during Spring Break, April 9-11. These passes simply identify you as a resident and will permit you to use the "coliseum shortcut" (Pine Grove to Beauvoir Road) at the north end of Pine Grove Avenue. The pass is to be placed on the driver-side dashboard where it can be seen by law enforcement officers. ***You will not be permitted to enter the "coliseum shortcut" at Beauvoir Road if you do not have this pass!***

This is important because there's a slight but significant change to BPD's Traffic Plan that affects you: If/When traffic becomes an issue, BPD will place barricades to prevent vehicles from entering Grande View Dr., Briarfield Ave and Pine Grove Ave. from Highway 90. (That's when you'll need the Neighborhood Pass for the coliseum shortcut!) If the circulation of traffic is never an issue, these streets will remain open to vehicles.

Orange traffic cones will be placed on Hwy 90 Friday morning, April 9.

Owners of two lots (Pine Grove & Hwy 90 and Grande View & Hwy 90) usually rented for parking said they've not been contacted by anyone to rent these properties.

The Biloxi Police Department continues to monitor social media and speak with past event promoters about this event. More Spring Break events are scheduled August 27-29.
