Avondale residences, Beach Blvd, between St. Jude Street and St. Paul Street, Biloxi, date unknown. Some of these homes were severely damaged in Hurricane Camille (1969) but repaired. None survived Hurricane Katrina (2005). They were magnificent reminders of homes on the Mississippi gulf coast owned by wealthy individuals who would spend their summers here.

Fireworks on the 4th... (City of Biloxi)

Biloxi's Independence Day fireworks show will take place Monday, July 4, at 9:00 pm. The 19-minute display is set to patriotic music and presented from a barge near Deer Island. Best viewing is from the Biloxi Lighthouse to the Biloxi Bay bridge. A fireworks-free zone, along the beach from Oak Street to the Biloxi Small Craft Harbor, is available to those attending the show. Remember to park in parking bays only, not in the center median of Highway 90. Be careful crossing Highway 90 and wear light-colored clothing. Traffic afterwards will be heavy and slow-moving so be patient. **Note:** It is unlawful to shoot fireworks within the city limits except for July 4 and December 31, 6:00 pm through 1:00 am, January 1.
