Late additions to the Council agenda...

There were two late additions to the agenda, one of which was item 4F, Resolution of Notice of Intent to amend Section 9-1-22(a) of the Code of Ordinances pertaining to garbage collection and disposal fees. Per the Resolution of Intent, the cost proposed will increase from \$15.75/month to \$17.00/month (or \$15/yr). To be clear, this Resolution was not to raise the rate, it was to let the public know the city *intends* to raise the rate. The vote on whether to raise the rate or not will occur in the weeks ahead. What bothers me is that the public was unaware of this addition to the agenda until the Council meeting began and missed the opportunity to comment, if anyone wished to do so. Some Resolutions are of an emergency nature and should be a late addition to the agenda; this was not one of them.
