

- Churchill Ave. ditch improvements: Contractor has begun investigation
- Edgewater Park Drainage Study: By Breeze Point, pending funding
- Fire Station #5: Design underway to expand/improve living area
- MGCCC traffic signal: Memo of Agreement approved, design has begun
- Popp's Ferry extension: Funding secured for construction, to be bid in 2023
