Scheduled water rate increase... See how the increase is calculated In 2020 the Council approved the Mayor's recommendation to increase the water rates anually over a four year period. October 1, will be see last increase of that four-year period. The increase was necessary to stabilize the Water & Sewer fund since it's a proprietary or enterprise account and must operate as a business.

West Biloxi boat launch update...

The entrance to the boat launch is scheduled to re-open August 11, if there are no weather delays. The frontage road (where infrastructure work is being done) will be limestone rock, not asphalt. Boaters had been taking a shortcut through Treasure Bay's parking lot (south of Hwy 90) to get to the launch but that is no longer permitted because of the damage to curbs and medians in the parking lot.
