**BEA1, 2, 3 infrastructure update**... <u>Video update</u> <u>Progress maps</u> Significant work that remains between Debuys Road – Beauvoir Road:

- ...Install all water, sewer and drainage from Debuys Road to Edgewater Mall
- ...Tie-in of newly installed water and sewer mains, remove existing water and sewer mains, between Edgewater Mall and Beauvoir Road
- ...Tie-in water and sewer services to residences and businesses
- ...Pave roads
- ...Contract duration runs to July, 2025; the contractor is ahead of schedule
- ...Sidewalk cleanup is the City's responsibility unless it was damaged or removed by the contractor during installation of the utilities
- ...Silt fencing's being removed; weed eating last week in Aug. or early Sept.

#### City emergency sirens...

The city's ten emergency sirens have not been used for several years because they are no longer operable due to lightning strikes; it would cost several hundred thousand dollars to service and repair them. Because it's quicker, the city encourages residents to use electronic emergency notification.
