Garbage & recycle pick up this week...

Waste Management and Pelican will not run on Monday, Christmas Day, so <u>all routes will run one day later than usual</u>. In Ward 5 that means pick up will be Saturday this week and next week (instead of Friday).

Coast Transit Authority...

There will be no bus service on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. New Year's Eve busses will run a regular Sunday schedule. There will be no bus service on Monday, January 1, New Year's Day.

Cardboard recycling...

Cardboard recycling will take place in Biloxi on Saturday, December 30, from 8:00 a.m. to Noon at the Edgewater mall south side parking lot by Starbucks. Here's your chance to get rid of all those boxes!

New ambulance service begins February 1, 2024... Hear the discussion Ambulance service, currently provided by American Medical Response (AMR), will transition to Pafford Emergency Medical Services (Pafford) during the month of January. Pafford will provide a minimum of 5 fully staffed and equipped ambulance units at all times with scalability up to 8 ambulances during peak deployment. Concerns about response time led to a Request for Proposals and concluded with the selection of Pafford.
