Golf carts (low-speed vehicles)... Read more...

Biloxi has legalized the use of approved low-speed vehicles, primarily golf carts, on city streets with limits of 25 mph or lower but it's not just a matter of jumping in the golf cart and driving down the street. Before being used legally, golf carts must be inspected by the police department and must have required safety features. The process includes an on-site inspection. After a successful inspection, the applicant must pay a \$75 fee at the police department before the annual registration sticker is installed.
