Six residents registered to compete for the Ward 4 Council seat in a Special Election set for Tuesday, June 18: Lara Bernich Alley, Jamie Creel, Dan Hunter, Rodney McGilvary, and Kim Compton Saucier. Douglas Schmitt registered but withdrew Wednesday evening. Ward 4 residents vote at the Margaret Sherry Library & Fire Station Complex, 2139 Popp's Ferry Road, between 7:00 am - 7:00 pm. If no candidate garners more than 50% of the vote, the top two finishers will vie in a runoff election, July 9.
