Short-term rentals... Need more info? General info Ordinance 2537 Short-term rentals can be a heated topic at times; here's the basics:

- ... A short-term rental is a rental property rented for 30 days or less.
- ... They are prohibited in Single-Family Residential zones.
- ... They are permitted by right in some commercial zones.
- ... They are permitted as a Conditional Use in residential multi-family zones and some commercial zones. Conditional Uses are approved by Council.
- ...List of approved/permitted short-term rentals in Biloxi as of 05/31/24
