

Do I need a Tree Permit? See the tree ordinance

(1) Trees that never require a permit: Pine Trees, Water Oak (Quercus Nigra), Pecan (Carya Illinoinensis) and Chinese Tallow or "Popcorn" (Sapium sebiferum). (2) Trees that require a permit if they are over 8 inches in diameter at breast height (dbh = 54 inches above ground): live Oak, Bald Cypress and Southern Magnolia. (3) All other trees require a permit if they are over 16 inches diameter at breast height (dbh) unless they are Pine, Water Oak, Pecan or Chinese Tallow ("Popcorn").
