Bay Vista subdivision water well & water lines approved, 12/30/24...

Residents in Bay Vista subdivision (Popp's Ferry Rd. west to Churchill Ave.; Old Bay Rd. south to Hinman Dr., Randall Dr. and MacArthur Ave.) will have their water lines replaced in 2025. <u>The \$3.3M project</u> includes replacing the Bay Vista water well which will increase the water pressure.
