Garbage pickup rescheduled...

The latest update from the Harrison County Utility Authority (HCUA)...

- (1) With the risk of roads conditions for ice tomorrow and below freezing temperatures tonight through late morning tomorrow, Solid Waste Collection routes (garbage, recycle, and yard waste) will not run and landfills will all be closed for Thursday January 23, 2025.
- (2) The revised schedule for Route recovery on all routes will be:
 - (A) Tuesday's routes will not be recovered this week. Any excess outside of the cart will be picked up and dumped on next Tuesday along with the normal cart pickup.
 - (B) Wednesday's Routes will run on Friday.
 - (C) Thursday's Routes will run on Saturday.
 - (D) Friday's routes will run on Sunday. Your day if you're in Ward 5
