Senior Citizen water rate, update...

The first round of Denial letters has been mailed out to residents who did not qualify for the new Senior water rates. If you received a Denial letter and have questions, please contact Bconnect at 228.435.6271 or bconnect@biloxi.ms.us. Letters to Seniors who have qualified and been approved for the Senior rate will go out in next week's mail. The new rate will be reflected in the water bill cycle of April 10. Residents who no longer qualify for the Senior rate are projected, based on typical water usage, to see an increase of about \$2.34 cents to their water bill based on the use of less than 3,000 gallons/month.
