Bond protest petition fails...

The effort, had it successfully gained the signatures of 1,500 registered voters in Biloxi would have required a bond election, an opportunity for the public to vote on the City's proposed bond issue. An examination of the petition revealed 1550 signatures were submitted. Of those, 282 were duplicates and 187 were not registered voters leaving 1081 valid signatures, short of the required number.
