## Popp's Ferry Road extension...

The Popp's Ferry Road extension, a major infrastructure project, is now more than 40 percent complete. On the south side, installation of water, sewer, and storm drain systems between Beach Boulevard and the railroad tracks is nearing completion, while work is underway on the retaining wall that leads up to the underpass. On the north side, crews have begun installing underground utilities for the next phase of the project. The project remains on schedule and is expected to be completed by the end of the year, weather permitting.
